Tuesday, November 11, 2025

The City Council of Mission Woods, Kansas met in regular session on Tuesday, November 11, 2025, in person at Westwood City Hall.

Mayor Hartley called the regular meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

Review and Approval of Minutes

Mayor Hartley asked for a Motion to approve the Minutes of the October 7, 2025, meeting. Motion to approve minutes was made by Councilmember Mays and seconded by Councilmember Sweeney. A voice vote was had, and the motion was approved, 3-0, Councilmembers Carto and Thomas were absent.

Review and Approval of Warrants

Council discussed the October warrants. A new legal publication platform was discussed. It was decided to look at other platforms and costs. After discussion a Motion to approve the October warrants was made by Councilmember Sweeney and seconded by Councilmember Mohsen. A voice vote was had, and the motion was approved, 3-0, Councilmembers Carto and Thomas were absent.

- **Approval of the 2026 Public Safety Service Agreement with Council consent**

Chief Mansel shared that nothing has really changed, the addition of the supplemental services/dedicated patrol is being continued. He stated there was a 5% increase cost, the

costs of which has already been budgeted for 2026. Chief Mansel stated that grants had been applied for and received for extra patrols in all three cities (Mission Woods, Westwood and Westwood Hills).

Motion to approve 2026 Public Safety Service Agreement was made by Councilmember Mohsen and seconded by Councilmember Mays. A roll call vote was had. Councilmembers Mays, Sweeney and Mohsen voted in the affirmative and the motion was approved, 3-0, Councilmembers Carto and Thomas were absent.

- **Name tag order for 2026-2028 elected officials**

Mayor Hartley shared her wish to order name tags for the 2026-2028 elected officials for use when in a situation when they are in the official capacity. The cost is \$45. It was decided to order the name tags.

Open to discussion from mayor, council members, and guests

Councilmember Mohsen shared the progress with KDOT and the study at Rainbow and Shawnee Mission Parkway. He stated that KDOT sent an independent consultant to study travel, pedestrians, etc. at Rainbow and Shawnee Mission Parkway. He stated it was pretty effective for the City's goal. Mayor Hartley stated that she believes they are still collecting data and that this study is more in depth than they expected.

Mayor Hartley shared that the road along State Line Road also needs to be paved. She stated they were going to apply for KARS fund during the 2026 cycle for funding in 2027. She stated that the Karbank construction would be done and those funds could be used to pave the road.

Councilmember Mays asked about the Rainbow Boulevard project. Mayor Hartley stated she was out of town and did not attend the August meeting but would get the information and have it for the next meeting. Mr. Martin stated that he was at the Westwood meeting last night and it was stated that there was no update.

Motion to Adjourn

Having no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Councilmember Sweeney and seconded by Councilmember Mohsen. A voice vote was had, and the motion was approved, 3-0, Councilmembers Carto and Thomas were absent. The meeting was adjourned at 7:28 p.m.
