I. Call to Order

Mayor Tietze called the meeting to order at 7:08 p.m. A quorum was not present.

II. Police Presentation

Mayor Tietze introduced Chief O'Halloran to discuss the Westwood Police Department's efforts to train staff and officers on issues related to race and interactions with a diverse community. After a lengthy presentation by Chief O'Halloran, Laurie Franklin, a resident of the City, addressed her concerns regarding the police department and race relations within the City.

III. General Comments

The Mayor then opened the agenda for general comments. Mayor Tietze stated that an additional expense was discovered for repairs to the sewer line and sink holes. The City Engineer and John

Sullivan will be reaching out to firms to obtain bids, which the Mayor will distribute to the Council. The City should expect the cost of the project to increase. The Mayor stated that there may be some collapsing on Shawnee Mission Parkway as a result of these issues, the same would be resolved by KDOT.
